

Decolonising and Diversifying our Curriculum, Research and Partnerships (DecCur) is an initiative introduced by six partner universities - University of Galway, University of the Basque Country - Euskal Herriko Unibertsitatea (UPV/EHU), University of Ghent, University of Groningen (RUG), University of Bourdeux, and University of Goettingen - and funded by Enlight Plus programme.

ENLIGHT is a European University alliance of ten comprehensive, research-intensive universities from ten European countries aiming to conduct an impact-driven and challenge-based transformation of European higher education to empower learners as globally engaged citizens with state-of-the-art knowledge and skills, while synergising our R&I potential with and for our societal partners, to tackle major societal transitions and to promote equitable quality of life and sustainability.
