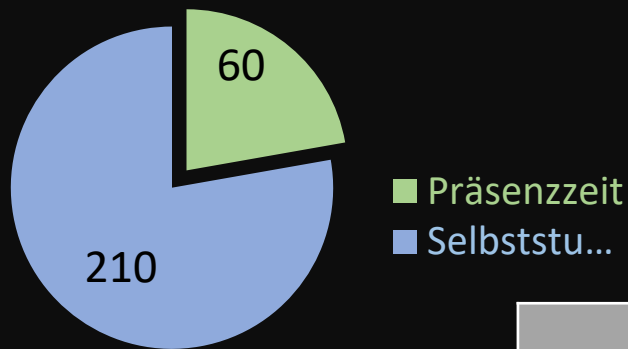


URBAN ANTHROPOLOGY

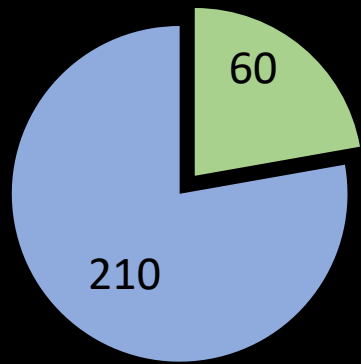
